Always concerned by the ecological footprint left on the environment, The Ducourt family decided to go further. During a visit to a friend's home, a winemaker in Languedoc Roussillon, Jeremy Ducourt discovered naturally disease resistant grape varieties. Enthused by the idea of growing vines that would be more respectful of the environment, he convinced the rest of his family to plant the very first vineyards of this kind in Bordeaux.

The family planted a 3 hectare vineyard devoted to both the red and white versions of these varieties.

The vines are the result of a natural cross between famous recognized varieties and more robust wild vines. These disease-resistant hybrids are a natural barrier against most common fungal disease; powdery and downy mildew, odium, and botrytis; a major step towards environmentally friendly viticulture. METISSAGE (French for Crossbreeding) is the unique result of that union – a truly UNIQUE wine.
